UK Tourism Industry's International Ranking

- The UK is the <u>eighth</u> largest international tourism destination ranked by visitor numbers.
- The first seven destinations are France, USA, Spain, China, Italy, Turkey and Germany.
- The UK is the <u>fifth</u> largest international tourism destination ranked by visitor expenditure.
- The first four destinations are USA, China, Spain and France
- The UK accounts for <u>3.6%</u> of global international tourism receipts.





ASSC Economic Impact Assessment of Short-Term Lettings on the Scottish Economy June 2017

- Carried out between July 2016 and March 2017, the report showed visitors spending:
  - £312.8m per annum in accommodation fees;
  - £118.5m on travel to and from self-catering properties;
  - £66.3m on food and drink in bars, cafes and restaurants;
  - £63.1m in supermarkets during their stay;
  - £45.1m on travel;
  - £27.5m on food and drink in local shops;
  - £24.8m on visitor attractions;
  - £17.1m on outdoor recreation.
- Of the <u>£723m</u> spent by those staying in self-catering properties, no less than <u>£470m</u> is spent by non-Scottish visitors.

• EU Digital Single Market Act:

EU has held consultations on (1) geo-blocking (i.e., imposing different pricing, transaction terms and general website access across borders) and other geographically-based restrictions and (2) the regulatory environment for platforms, online intermediaries, and cloud computing.

• EU Accessibility Act:

Could mandate accessibility standards for private websites.

• EU Package Travel Directive:

Passed and with member states for enactment.

• General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR):

Coming May 2018.
