Next steps for Scotland's Census 2022

- Households across Scotland who haven't completed their census are being urged to complete as soon as possible and are being offered a short extension until the end of May to complete their return.
- By allowing outstanding online and paper returns to be submitted over a further four weeks, we are ensuring that everyone across the country has the opportunity to complete their return and help to shape important services in their community. Around 68,000 households have begun their census returns online but have not yet been completed and a similar number of requested paper forms have yet to be returned.
- The contact centre **0800 030 8308** is still open and can assist with a range of queries including access to language support with an interpreter and requests for other accessible questionnaire formats and guidance (such as large print, braille, BSL videos on USB and DVD etc.)
- Reminder letters have been sent out to households who have still not yet responded.
- We have released a new [television advert](#) reminding those who have still to complete their census and also of their legal responsibility to complete the census.

- Our field force staff continue to visit households to offer help and advice on how to complete their census.
